Created in 1976, CDEFI's objective is to represent the interests of these institutions at national, European, and international levels. Engineering schools in French higher education: Major providers of master-level training

1. Each year, 33,000 students obtain a French engineering degree
2. 21% of all master's and master-level degrees are engineering diplomas
3. 2/3 of master-level degrees in science and technology are engineering diplomas
